**RENIER ANNOUNCES CAMPAIGN FOR CONGRESS****VETERANS SHOW SUPPORT WITH FLAG CEREMONY AT NOON**

Along with throngs of supporters braving a beautiful Michigan, winter day, Sharon Renier announced her 2008 run for US Congress to represent Michigan's 7<sup>th</sup> Congressional District.
